

SEASONAL INFLUENZA 2011-2012

Everyone 6 months and older should get flu vaccine each year starting with the 2011-2012 season.

This year's seasonal flu vaccine **contains the H1N1-like influenza virus**, so there is **no need** for two separate vaccines.

The Chautauqua County Department of Health will be offering seasonal influenza vaccinations to anyone who would like them at regularly scheduled Health Department immunization clinics **beginning in November**. The following vaccination clinics are open to **ANYONE** who would like to receive the vaccine.

Walk in clinic dates and locations are:

Dunkirk Health Department, 1136 Central Avenue
November 2nd and November 16th from 1pm to 4pm

Jamestown Health Department, 110 East Fourth Street 1st floor
November 3rd from 9-11am and 1-4pm and November 10th from 1-4pm

Mayville Health Department, 7 North Erie Street, HRC Building 4th Floor
October 27th from 1-4pm
